God sent us the money and we are having it at a theatre here that one of the colleges own. While it is expensive, it is a good place and it's downtown as well. God has provided and we are thankful. As we were in the planning stages the manager that we were dealing with had a stroke and put a delay on a lot of important details, but we know God will work even through that.
